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Annual Report of the Public Service Commission West Bengal

For the year 2014-2015

(1st April 2014 to 31st March 2015)

PART—I

BRIEF HISTORY

- 1) The evolution of the Public Service Commission in India can be traced back to the persistent demands raised by the educated Indians for admission into the Indian Civil Service. The Montagu-Chelmsford report incorporated a provision regarding this demand of the Indian Youth and ultimately the Govt. of India Act, 1919 saved the path for the formation of the Public Service Commissions. Section 96C of the Govt. of India Act, 1919 provided for the establishment of a Public Service Commission in India to regulate the recruitment and control the public services in India and perform such functions as may be assigned thereto by Rules made by the Secretary of State in Council.
- 2) The passing of the Govt. of India Act, 1919 was followed by a protracted correspondence stretching over four years between the Secretary of State, the Govt. of India and local Governments regarding the framework of the body to be constituted. Subsequently, the Lee Commission in its report dated 27th March, 1924, recommended the establishment of the Public Service Commission as suggested by the Government of India Act, 1919 without any further delay.
- 3) Pursuant to the provisions of the Section 96(C) of the Govt. of India Act, 1919 and the recommendation of the Lee Commission, Central Public Service Commission was set up for the first time in India in October, 1926. It was formed in accordance with the traditions of the British Civil Service Commission. The functions of the Public Service Commission were regulated by the Public Service Commission (Functions) Rules, 1926 framed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 96(C) of the Government of India Act, 1919. These rules provided for consultation with the Commission in respect of recruitment to All India Services, Central Services Class I and Class II, on questions of drawing up of syllabi for examinations and of qualifications for recruitment by selection, on promotion to these services, on disciplinary cases, on questions connected with pay and allowances, pension, provident funds, leave rules and conditions of service.
- 4) The next significant development in the history of Public Service Commission in India was the issuance of a White Paper in December, 1931 delineating proposals for Indian Constitutional Reforms. The White Paper also contained a blue print of the Public Service Commissions for the proposed Federation and the provinces. The report of the Joint Committee on Indian Constitutional Reforms (1934) further reiterated the need for setting up a federal PSC and a PSC for each province. The Govt. of India Act, 1935 envisaged a Public Service Commission for the federation and a Provincial Public Service Commission for each Province or Group of Provinces.
- 5) In terms of the provisions of this Act and its coming into effect on 1st April, 1937, a Public Service Commission was formed in each province except in cases of certain provinces which

formed the Joint Public Service Commissions. This is the background for the emergence of Bengal Public Service Commission in 1937 and its continuance as the PSC, West Bengal.

- 6) The Constituent Assembly realized the importance of giving a secure and autonomous status to the Public Service Commissions both at Federal and Provincial levels for ensuring recruitment to Civil Services without any prejudiced and protection of service interests. With the promulgation of the new Constitution for independent India on 26th January, 1950, Public Service Commissions in the States were accorded a Constitutional Status in terms of Article 315.
- 7) After its formation, the PSC, W.B. started functioning from Bhabani Bhavan, Alipore. Subsequently, Examination Section of the office shifted to Town Hall, Kolkata while rest of the office operated from Bhabani Bhavan. After several years, the Town Hall was vacated and the Examination Section was accommodated in a building adjacent to Bhabani Bhavan. At that time, 2 floors of a building near Sealdah were used as examination venue. In the year 1989, the entire office of the PSC, W.B. was shifted to a newly constructed building at 161A, S.P. Mukherjee Road, Mudiali, Near Tollygunge Rly. Bridge. All the sections of the P.S.C., W.B. as well as exam. Venues are at present located in this building.

PART—II
GENERAL

As a body enshrined in the constitution of India, the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, has sincerely remained active in discharging its constitutional duties and living up to its tradition as inherited from the Bengal Public Service Commission that was formed under the Government of India Act, 1935 and which started functioning with effect from April, 1937. A report on its working during the year 2014-2015 is set forth hereunder.

The Annual Report, 2014-2015 of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal has been compiled delineating the various aspects of activity of the different sections of the Commission. An attempt has been made to give a thorough representation of the administrative structure and functions of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal with statistical data pertaining to the examinations/selection procedures conducted, candidates recommended and other important information linked to the duties performed by the Commission during the year 2014-2015. In addition, the last 10 years' data have been incorporated to represent the workload and to benefit the researchers administrators and interested parties alike in terms of knowledge and inputs.

During the last couple of years, special initiatives have been undertaken regarding implementation of e-governance in the Public Service Commission, West Bengal. The Commission by leveraging information technology resources has made substantial progress in reducing the time gap between publication of an advertisement of a recruitment examination/selection procedure and declaration of results thereof.

The system of on line application has been introduced in the recent past. It permits on-line filling of applications by the candidates and allows eligible applicants to download e-admit cards. Special steps have contributed to faster publication of results.

Another significant achievement of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, has been the introduction of One Time Registration Facility for candidates by providing unique ID and password through SMS & Emails. Candidates who have registered can edit their profile with respect to certain fields like qualification, experience etc. at any point of time and when they apply for any post. The Commission has contemplated to introduce more path breaking initiatives in the near future to achieve maximum efficiency in its core functions.

4. Functions of the Commission :

The Constitution of India has enjoined consultation with the Public Service Commission on matters of appointment and certain other matters as specified in Article 320 in respect of the Civil Services and posts. The Public Service Commission has to perform the duties relating to matters specified in that Article. These include conducting examinations for appointment to Civil Services and posts under the State Government and advising the State Government on all matters relating to methods of recruitment to Civil Services and posts, on the principles to be followed in making appointments to Civil Services and posts and in making promotions and transfers from one service to another, on the suitability of candidates for such appointments, promotions or transfers and on all disciplinary matters affecting a person serving under the State Government in a civil capacity and on certain other matters.

Article 229 and Article 234 also contain provisions in terms of which the Commission is required to be consulted in matters of appointment to certain categories of posts in offices attached to the High Court and to the State Judicial Service respectively. Besides, Acts made for certain statutory bodies contain provisions for consultation with the Commission in matters of appointment to certain categories of posts under such bodies. Article 321 also contains provision in terms of which additional functions may be entrusted to the Commission by an Act made by the State Legislature as respects the services of the State or any local authority or anybody corporate or any public institution. Such an Act has, however, not been made till now.

The Commission is consulted by the State Govt. in making recruitment to a majority of Civil Services and posts. However, some posts under the State Govt. have been kept outside the purview of the Commission by making regulations in terms of the proviso to Article 320(3) of the Constitution. Such regulations are the West Bengal Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 2008.

5. Workload of the Commission :

A statistical account of the main items of work performed by the Commission during the year 2014-2015 is given in the following pages under the caption : **Workload at a Glance**.

During the period under report, the Commission held 493 sittings to interview and select candidates for direct recruitment to various services and posts. Altogether 6315 candidates were called in for interviews. The Commission continued its practice of inviting experts of different disciplines to assist it in the matter of selection of candidates and thus it maintained liaison with various universities, institutions and organizations.

For direct recruitment by competitive examination with or without interview, the Commission held 07(seven) different kinds of recruitment examinations including Assistant Engineer (Civil) Recruitment Examination, 2014, West Bengal Judicial Service (Preliminary) Examination, 2014, West Bengal Judicial Service (Final) Examination, 2014, West Bengal Civil Service (Exe.) Etc.

(Preliminary) Examination,2014, Miscellaneous Services Recruitment (Final) Examination,2012, West Bengal Civil Service (Exe.) Etc.(Main) Examination,2014,West Bengal Forest Service and West Bengal Sub-ordinate Forest Service (Main) Examination,2013, There were altogether **1,28,451** candidates applied, **1,38,155** candidates allowed and 93,728 candidates appeared for these examinations including **6,953** candidates in the **04** (four) Main Examinations. During the year under report, the Commission allotted, **2,217** candidates including **485** Scheduled Caste, **158** Scheduled Tribe and 283(B.C.'A'-112,B.C.'B'-171) Backward Class candidates for appointment to different services and posts on the results of different recruitment examinations.

For direct recruitment through selection by interview (with or without preliminary written test) the Commission advertised **1060** posts of different categories and received altogether **38,646** applications. Preliminary written tests were held for 54 categories of posts for the purpose of short-listing of candidates. After selection, during the period under report, the Commission recommended 867 candidates including **183** S.C., **50** S.T., **61** B.C.(A), **72** B.C.(B) and **04** P.H. candidates for appointment to different services and posts. The Commission also recommended another **75** candidates including **21** S.C. candidates, **11** (B.C.'A'-07, B.C.'B'-04) Backward Class candidates, and **01** P.H. candidate for appointment to different services and posts from the reserve lists prepared on earlier selections.

For promotion, the Commission held **114** sittings to discuss the cases with the representatives of the concerned departments of the State Government. Altogether, **1165** vacancies in different services and posts were reported to the Commission for being filled up by promotion. During the period under report, the Commission recommended **1108** officers for promotion after considering cases of **3849** officers and could not make any recommendation against **57** vacancies for various reasons.

In disciplinary matters, during the period under report, the Govt. forwarded **86** cases (**41** fresh and **45** old) to the Commission for advice. The Commission was able to tender its advice only in **30** cases, while the remaining **48** cases were sent back to the Govt. asking for necessary papers/particulars and **26** cases were pending with the Commission till the closing of the year (i.e. **31/03/2015**).

The Commission also tendered advice on framing of recruitment rules for **44** different categories of services and posts and on **01** case regarding revision of examination rules.

During the year under report, the Commission held Half-Yearly Departmental Examination in May & November, **2014** each time for **7** different categories of officers serving under the Govt. of West Bengal including those of I.A.S. probationers. The total number of registered candidates for the Departmental Examinations was **4,981**.

Despite the fact that Commission performs its function according to the rules and regulations, the commission was impleaded as a Respondent in a number of court cases during the period under report. The cases were defended as per the rules and regulations as well as on the strength of records relating to the case. 67 fresh litigations, 01 in the Hon'ble Supreme Court, 24 in the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and 42 in the Hon'ble West Bengal Administrative Tribunal were filed involving the Commission during the period under report, out of which 31 cases (16 in the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and 15 in the Hon'ble West Bengal Administrative Tribunal) were contested by the Commission. Besides, 85 cases (including old pending cases), 02 in the Hon'ble Supreme Court, 65 in the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, 18 in the Hon'ble West Bengal Administrative Tribunal against the Commission are pending. Apart from the aforesaid cases, 17 cases, 12 in the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, and in 05 in the Hon'ble West Bengal Administrative Tribunal were disposed of during the period under report.

Table I intra gives previous and current year's figures on certain items of work.

6. OBSERVATIONS

A. Requirement of consultation with the Commission regarding promotion:

The Commission has noticed that the proviso to Article 320(3) (b) is being interpreted by many Departments of the Government that consultation with the Commission is not necessary for making promotion from one post to another where the posts are (i) within the same service and (ii) not belonging to any service (i.e. the posts of West Bengal. General Service). The Commission is of the view that such interpretation would not be in consonance with the spirit of the Constituion. The Patna High Court in the case of Hariprasad Vs. State (AIR-1972, Patna-4) and the Supreme Court in the case of Jammu and Kashmir Vs. Rajdulari Rajdan and others (AIR 1979-SC-586 and 587) gave the judgement in favour of consultation with the Commission in all cases of promotions. It is mentioned in this connection that the Union Public Service Commission after discussion on the point at the National Conference of the Chairmen of the State Public Service Commissions, has sought an amendment to Article 320(3)(b) in its memorandum to the National Commission set up to review the working of the Constitution so that the scope of interpreting the existing expression in the Article is obviated and the Commission is consulted in making promotions from one post to another.

The Commission expects that the State Government would consider the matter and take steps so that the Commission is consulted in making promotions from one post to another in all cases.

B. Reporting of vacancies to the Commission for various recruitment examinations :

The Commission has been experiencing difficulties in obtaining estimates of vacancies from the Departments of Government in time. In some cases much delay occurs in reporting vacancies to the Commission despite urgent requests and repeated reminders. Consequently, holding of personality tests after the written examinations in the concerned cases gets deferred and finalization of results of the examinations is delayed. Often vacancies are reported long after the completion of personality tests. Such vacancies cannot be accepted for that particular examination and remain to be filled up on the results of the next examination. Needless to mention that an estimate of vacancies is necessary for the Commission to fix up the number of candidates for the personality tests and once the personality test is completed on the basis of the estimated record, further vacancies for the particular examination cannot be accepted.

The Commission feels that it may be possible for the Departments of the Government to make a forecast of vacancies to occur in a year due to retirement. Additional vacancies due to resignations and/or creation of posts can also be accommodated mostly by the time the estimate of vacancies is required for the personality test. Such procedure should be followed in the cases of annual recruitment examinations in view of the difficulties mentioned above.

An annual calendar of vacancies in the posts within the purview of the annual recruitment examinations may be prepared and maintained by the appointing authority so that an estimate of vacancies in the posts for the annual recruitment examinations could be furnished positively by the 31st of March of the year of the examinations taking into account the vacancies to be available by the 31st of December of that year.

C. Disciplinary cases—Incomplete reference from Government Departments :

The Commission reiterates its earlier observation that the disciplinary cases are mostly referred to it for advice without furnishing necessary documents and particulars. Such cases are therefore required to be sent back to the Departments concerned and thus it is unnecessarily delayed.

D. Extension of Pre-examination Training Facilities :

The Commission in its earlier annual reports tendered advice in favour of the extension of the existing facilities of pre-examination training of SC/ST candidates. for various recruitment examinations. It is noticed that a good number of vacancies reported for these categories of candidates remained unfilled for want of suitable candidates, even after sufficiently lowering the general standard, during the period under report. The Commission suggests that the Government may consider opening training centres in various places in the State, especially in the tribal concentrated districts.

E. Departmental Examinations—Ensuring Appearance of the officers at the Examinations :

It has come to the notice of the Commission that quite a large number of officers whose cases are forwarded to it and who are admitted to these examinations do not appear at the examinations, causing much inconvenience to the Commission as also wastage of time and drainage of money. So, the Commission suggests that the officers applying for the Departmental Examinations should be instructed by the Departments / Officers concerned to appear at the examinations without fail.

Important particulars of the recruitment examinations held during the year 2014-2015 are as follows :—

(i) Assistant Engineer (Civil) Recruitment Examination, 2013 : Date of Examination — 13.04.2014 :

The examination was held at 9 venues in Kolkata including the Commission's Examination Halls. In all 3,553 candidates applied for the examination of whom 2,641 candidates took the same out of 3,340 registered candidates.

(ii) West Bengal Judicial Service (Preliminary) Examination, 2014 : Date of Examination — 18.05.2014 :

The examination was held at 6 venues in Kolkata and 1 venue in Darjeeling. In all 2,103 candidates applied for the examination of whom 1,889 candidates were admitted. 1,345 candidates took their examination.

(iii) West Bengal Judicial Service (Final) Examination, 2014: Dates of Examination— 19.07.2014 to 28.07.2014 (except 26th & 27th July, 2014) :

On the basis of the results of preliminary examination, 625 candidates were allowed to take the final. examination held at the Examination Halls of P.S.C. of whom 584 candidates appeared.

- (iv) West Bengal Civil Service (Executive) Etc. (Preliminary) Examination, 2014 : Date of Examination — 03.08.2014 :

The examination was held in 17 centres throughout West Bengal including Darjeeling. Number of venues at different centres were as follows :—

Kolkata (North) — 48, Kolkata (South) — 35, Baruipur — 14, Barrackpore — 30, Barasat — 28, Howrah — 13. Burdwan — 20, Asansol — 9, Medinipur — 15, Tamluk — 8, Bankura — 9, Berhampore — 19, Malda — 16, Jalpaiguri — 8, Cooch Behar — 13, Siliguri — 18, Darjeeling — 5.

In all 1,22,795 candidates applied for the examination all of whom were allowed to appear at the examination. Finally, 82,789 candidates appeared at the examination.

- (v) Miscellaneous Services Recruitment (Final) Examination, 2012: Date of Examination — 31.08.2014 :

On the basis of the results of preliminary examination, 3,929 candidates were allowed to take the final examination held at the 11 venues at Kolkata including the Commission's Examination Halls. Finally, 2,313 candidates appeared at the examination.

- (vi) West Bengal Civil Service (Executive) etc. (Main) Examination, 2014 : Dates of Examination — 21.12.2014 to 27.12.2014 (except 24th, 25th & 26th December, 2014) :

On the basis of the results of preliminary examination, 4,354 candidates were allowed to take the main examination held at 12 venues in Kolkata including the Commission's Examination Halls. Finally, 3,413 candidates appeared at the examination.

- (vii) West Bengal Forest Service and West Bengal Subordinate Forest Service (Main) Examination, 2013 : Dates of Examination — 16.01.2015 to 29.01.2015 (except 18th, 25th & 26th January, 2015) :

On the basis of the results of preliminary examination, 1,223 candidates were allowed to take the main examination held at 4 venues in Kolkata including the Commission's Examination Halls. Finally, 643 candidates appeared at the examination.

- (i) Limited Departmental Examination of eligible employees of the Govt. of West Bengal for promotion to the posts of Disaster Management Officer under the Directorate of Disaster Management, Govt. of West Bengal, 2013 : Date of Examination — 03.11.2014.

The examination was held at the Commission's Examination Hall at Kolkata. 304 candidates applied for the examination of whom 232 candidates were admitted. 138 candidates appeared at the examination.

- (ii) Limited Departmental Examination of eligible employees of the Govt. of West Bengal for promotion to the posts in West Bengal Audit and Accounts Service, 2014 : Dates of Examination — 18.11.2014, 19.11.2014 & 20.11.2014.

The examination was held at the Commission's Examination Hall at Kolkata. 331 candidates applied for the examination of whom 321 candidates were admitted. 146 candidates appeared at the examination.

8. DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATIONS :

During the year under report, Half-yearly Departmental Examination was held in May and November of officers of 7 (seven) different categories serving under the Government of West Bengal. In May, 2014, number of officers registered for the examination was 2,487 of

whom 1,173 officers appeared. In November, 2014, the number of registered candidates and appeared candidates were 2,494 and 1,043 respectively. In May and November, 2013, the position was as follows— In May, registered candidates= 2,590 & Present candidates = 1,072. In November, registered candidates = 2,385 & Present candidates = 950.

DIRECT RECRUITMENT

11. Recruitment after advertisement and interviews:

During the year under report the commission considered the proposals from Government reporting altogether 1135 posts of various categories for appointment, after advertisement and interviews for recommendation from the reserve lists. Details are given in Appendix-II (A) & Appendix-II (B) (synopsis)- 252 of the above posts were reserved for members of S.C., 79 for S.T., 107 for B.C.(A), 83 for B.C.(B), and 33 for P.H. candidates.

Regarding the 1135 posts, as above, the commission took action as follows —

- (a) Recommended from its previous reserve lists 75 candidates including 21 S.C., 07 B.C.(A) & 04 B.C.(B) and 01 P.H. candidates.
- (b) Advertised the remaining 1060 posts including 231 posts reserved for S.C., 79 for S.T., 100 for B.C.(A) and 79 for B.C.(B) and 32 P.H. candidates.

In response to the advertisements mentioned at (b) above 38646 applications including 10012 from S.C., 833 from S.T., 1876 from B.C.(A), 3454 from B.C.(B) and 136 from P.H. candidates were received.

The number of candidates called for interview during the year under report was 3593 including 782 S.C., 156 S.T., 279 B.C.(A), 367 B.C.(B) and 18 P.H. candidates. Out of whom 3096 candidates including 659 S.C., 137 S.T., 245 B.C.(A), 330 B.C.(B). and 18 P.H. candidates appeared at the interviews. The Commission held 644 sittings during the year under report for interviewing the candidates.

Out of 1060 vacancies advertised, the Commission recommended candidates for appointment to 867 vacancies including 497 for general candidates [15 S.C., 07 S.T., 12 B.C.(A), & 24 B.C.(B) candidates ranked amongst the general candidates on merit were recommended against unreserved vacancies], 183 for S.C., 50 for S.T., 61 B.C.(A), 72 for B.C.(B) & 04 for P.H. candidates. In respect of the remaining 193 posts including 138 reserved for S.C., 29 for S.T., 39 for B.C.(A), 07 for B.C.(B) & 28 for P.H. candidates, no candidates was available and hence the Commission could not make any recommendation. Of these posts 156 teaching posts under Education Department and the remaining 37 posts were non-teaching posts requiring technical and /or professional qualification.

In all, therefore, the Commission could recommend 942 candidates during the year under report including 204 posts reserved for S.C., 50 for S.T., 68 for B.C.(A), 76 for B.C.(B) & 05 for P.H. candidates — of which 75 from its earlier reserve lists and 867 on the basis of advertisements issued by the Commission. Framing of recruitment rules in respect of 44 different services and posts under Government, the details of which may be seen in Appendix IVA.

14. Examination Reforms Cell :

During the year under report the Commission considered and tendered advice on 1 (One) case regarding revision of examination rules which is not finalised by the Government during the year under report. Details are given in Appendix-IV B.

PART—VIII

Disciplinary Cases

2014-15

During the year under report 86 (eighty six) cases were referred to the Commission for advice of which 41 (forty one) cases were referred to the Commission for the first time and 45 (forty five) cases which had been referred to the Commission earlier but returned for want of requisite documents and other particulars related to those cases. 18 (eighteen) cases had been pending with the Commission till the close of the previous year. On verification 48 (forty eight) cases including some of the old cases were found wanting in relevant documents / particulars and were returned to the Govt. among which in one case the Govt. had issued final order without receiving formal recommendation of the Commission but cancelled the order later on 26 (twenty six) cases were under examination of the Commission till the close of the year under report. The Commission, in the process, could tender advice in 30 (thirty) cases during the year under report details of which are shown in Appendix-V. In 28 (twenty eight) cases the Govt. reported acceptance of the recommendation of the Commission. Regarding the remaining 2 (two) cases the decision of the Govt. has not been communicated to the Commission till the close of the year under report.

In last year's Annual Report 3 (three) cases were shown pending with the Govt. for decision to be taken on the advice of the Commission. Subsequently, the Govt. intimated acceptance of the recommendation of the Commission in 2 (two) cases but the decision of the Govt. regarding the remaining 1 (one) case has not been intimated till the close of the year under report.

16. Irregular Appointment

There was no case where the Government made irregular appointment to any post within the purview of the recruitment examinations conducted by the Commission during the year under report.

PART—X

17. Overriding Case

In October, 2009 the Govt. in the Department of Health & Family Welfare moved the Commission soliciting its views on the issue of guilt & punishment to be imposed upon 3 (three) officers belonging to the ranks of 1) Superintendent, 2) Medical Officer & 3) Nursing Superintendent in a case of Common Departmental Proceedings. Among these three officers, the officer holding the post of Medical Officer was proceeded against the charge that while posted at B.C. Roy Hospital, his frequent absence, misconduct, lack of punctuality and defiance of authority vitiated the overall atmosphere of the Hospital. The aforesaid observation was noticed by a high power committee headed by Hon'ble MIC during a routine visit after the unfortunate demise of several children suffering from multiple condition and complication at that hospital.

The Commission found the officer guilty and recommended the penalty of reduction of pay of the officer by 1 (one) increment in respective Pay Band for a period of 2 (two) years with the direction that he will not earn any increment of pay during the period of such reduction and on expiry of such period the reduction will not have the effect of postponing his future increments under rule 8(iv) of WBS(C.C.& A.) Rules, 1971. In March, 2015 the Department concerned unilaterally issued Final Order imposing upon the Officer lesser penalty in the form of withholding of 1 (one) annual increment for a period of 2 (two) years without cumulative effect under rule 8(ii) of WBS(C.C.& A.) Rules, 1971. Such activity on the part of the Disciplinary Authority is very much irregular in nature. It is to be mentioned here that the Department concerned issued final orders in the year 2010-11 imposing penalty upon the other 2 (two) Charged Officers in accordance with the recommendation of the Commission.

PART—XI

18. Recruitment Rules/Service Rules

During the year under report, the Commission has dealt with one (01) case regarding revision of examination rules and has tendered its advice to the Government. The Government till the closing of the year did not finalize that case and that case is still pending with the government vide Appendix-IV-B.

Besides, the Commission during the year under report also tendered advice on framing of recruitment rules for forty four (44) different categories of services and posts from thirteen (13) different departments under the Government of West Bengal. In the previous year, corresponding figures were forty four (44) and nine (09) respectively.

PART—XII

19. R.T.I. CELL, P.S.C., W.B.

Annual Report for the period from 01.04.2014 to 31.03.2015

During the year under report total 744 (Seven Hundred and Forty Four) cases were received by S.P.I.O., P.S.C., W.B. under R.T.I. Act, 2005 soliciting various information. Amongst these R.T.I. aspirants, 35 (Thirty Five) made First Appeals to the Appellate Authority, P.S.C. as well. A good number of petitioners put forth multiple representations at times. The S.P.I.O. and Appellate Authority in the office of the P.S.C., W.B. responsibly accomplished the task of dispatching replies to all the information seekers within the time limit as specified under R.T.I. Act, 2005. It is worthwhile to mention that only 2 (Two) R.T.I. cases were eventually referred by the information seekers to the West Bengal Information Commission for hearing which were duly attended by the R.T.I. officials of P.S.C., W.B. The judgements delivered by West Bengal Information Commission after those hearings were strictly adhered to by the S.P.I.O., P.S.C., W.B.

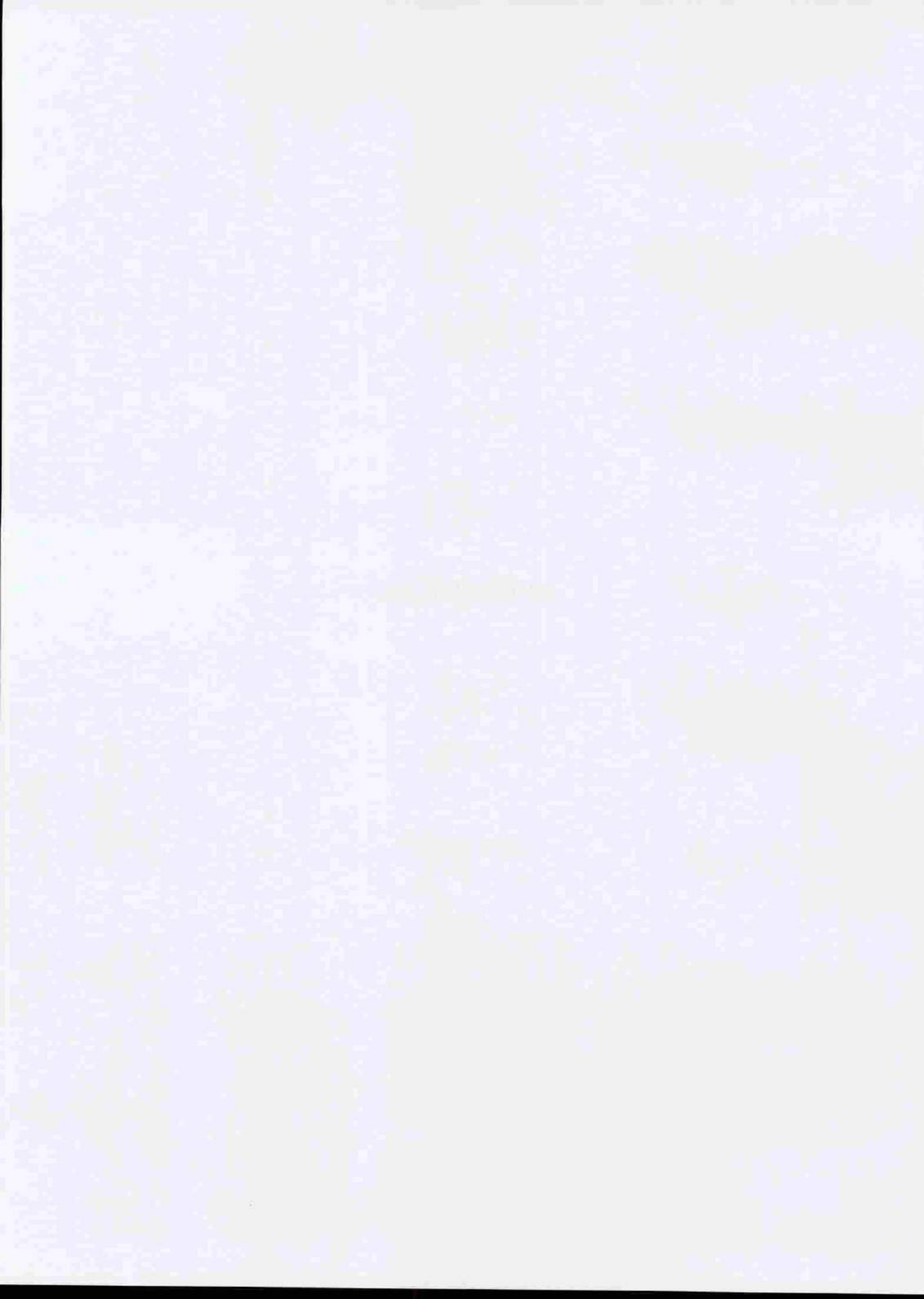
