

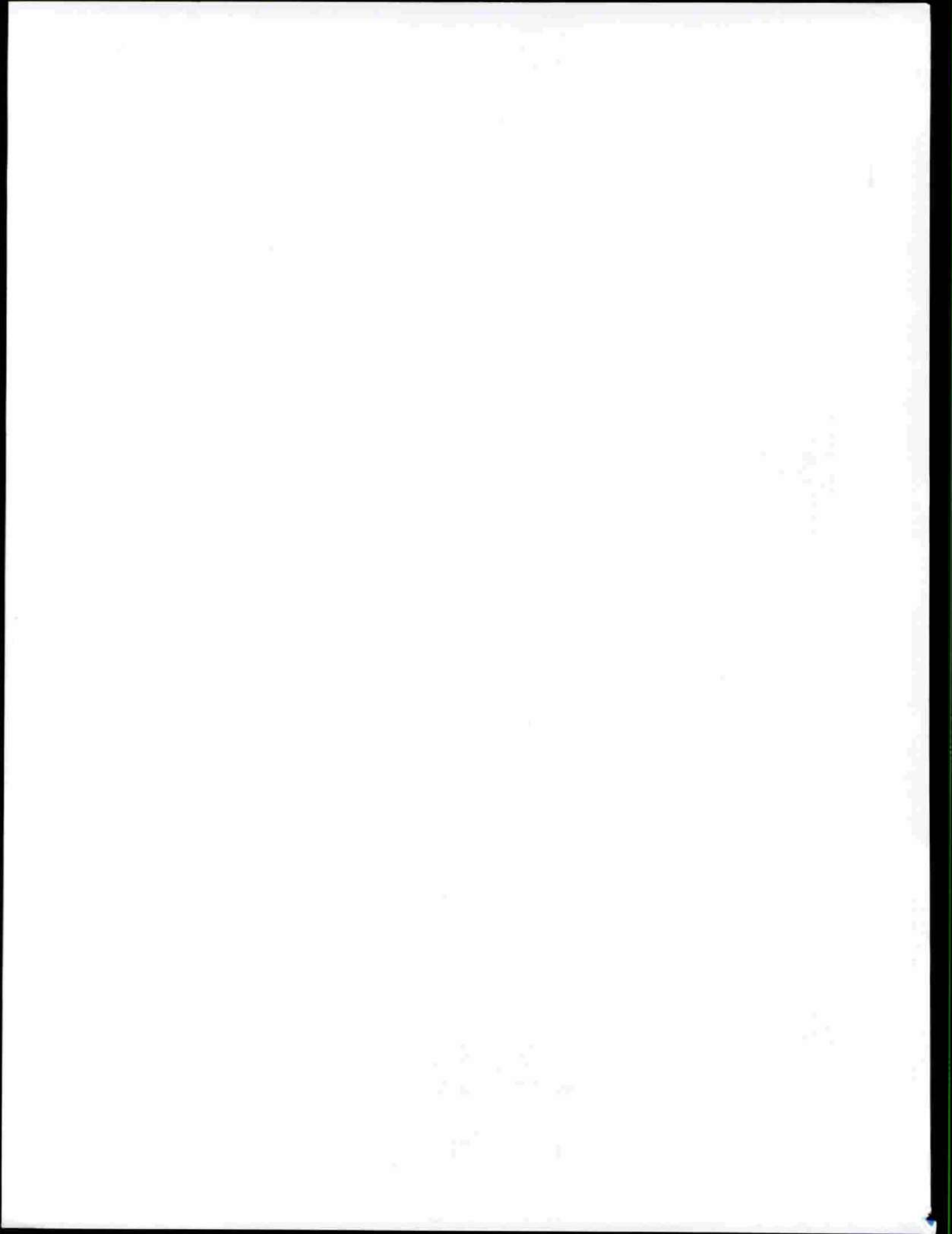

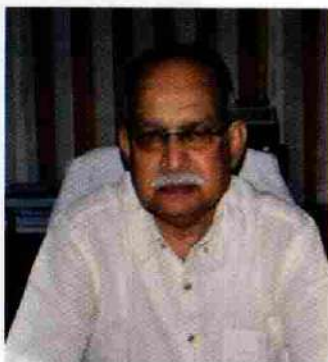

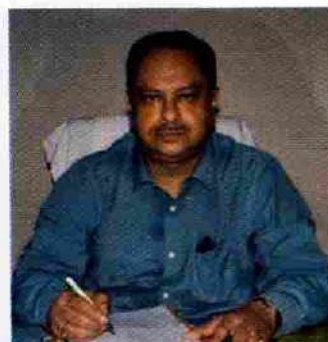

PART-I

BRIEF HISTORY

(1) The evolution of the Public Service Commission in India can be traced back to the persistent demands raised by the educated Indians for admission into the Indian Civil Service. The Montagu-Chelmsford report incorporated a provision regarding this demand of the Indian Youth and ultimately the Govt. of India Act, 1919 saved the path for the formation of the Public Service Commissions. Section 96C of the Govt. of India Act, 1919 provided for the establishment of a Public Service Commission in India to regulate the recruitment and control the public services in India and perform such functions as may be assigned thereto by Rules made by the Secretary of State in Council.

(2) The passing of the Govt. of India Act, 1919 was followed by a protracted correspondence stretching over four years between the Secretary of State, the Govt. of India and local Governments regarding the framework of the body to be constituted. Subsequently, the Lee Commission in its report dated 27th March, 1924, recommended the establishment of the Public Service Commission as suggested by the Government of India Act, 1919 without any further delay.

(3) Pursuant to the provisions of the Section 96(C) of the Govt. of India Act, 1919 and the recommendation of the Lee Commission, Central Public Service Commission was set up for the first time in India in October, 1926. It was formed in accordance with the traditions of the British Civil Service Commission. The functions of the Public Service Commission were regulated by the Public Service Commission (Functions) Rules, 1926 framed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 96(C) of the Government of India Act, 1919. These rules provided for consultation with the Commission in respect of recruitment to All India Services, Central Services Class I and Class II, on questions of drawing up of syllabi for examinations and of qualifications for recruitment by selection, on promotion to these services, on disciplinary cases, on questions connected with pay and allowances, pension, provident funds, leave rules and conditions of service.

(4) The next significant development in the history of Public Service Commission in India was the issuance of a White Paper in December, 1931 delineating proposals for Indian Constitutional Reforms. The White Paper also contained a blue print of the Public Service Commissions for the proposed Federation and the provinces. The report of the Joint Committee on Indian Constitutional Reforms (1934) further reiterated the need for setting up a federal PSC and a PSC for each province. The Govt. of India Act, 1935 envisaged a Public Service Commission for the federation and a Provincial Public Service Commission for each Province or Group of Provinces.

(5) In terms of the provisions of this Act and its coming into effect on 1st April, 1937, a Public Service Commission was formed in each province except in cases of certain provinces which formed the Joint Public Service Commissions. This is the background for the emergence of Bengal Public Service Commission in 1937 and its continuance as the PSC, West Bengal.

(6) The Constituent Assembly realized the importance of giving a secure and autonomous status to the Public Service Commissions both at Federal and Provincial levels for ensuring recruitment to Civil Services without any prejudice and protection of service interests. With the promulgation of the new Constitution for independent India on 26th January, 1950, Public Service Commissions in the States were accorded a Constitutional Status in terms of Article 315.

7) After its formation, the PSC, W.B. started functioning from Bhabani Bhavan, Alipore. Subsequently, Examination Section of the office shifted to Town Hall, Kolkata while rest of the office operated from Bhabani Bhavan. After several years, the Town Hall was vacated and the Examination Section was accommodated in a building adjacent to Bhabani Bhavan. At that time, 2 floors of a building near Sealdah were used as examination venue. In the year 1989, the entire office of the PSC, W.B. was shifted to a newly constructed building at 161A, S.P. Mukherjee Road, Mudiali, near Tollygunge Rly. Bridge. All the sections of the P.S.C., W.B. as well as exam. venues are at present located in this building.

The Annual Report for the year ending on 31st March, 2019 has since been compiled. The core functions and the activities of the various sections of the Commission's Secretariat have been highlighted in the Annual Report. Data in respect of the examinations/selection procedures conducted, candidates recommended for employment, important information linked to the duties performed by the Commission have been incorporated to give an idea about the workload of the Commission during the period from 1st April, 2018 to 31st March, 2019.

The initiatives undertaken by the Commission to utilize the information and technology resources in its operations have started yielding results. The reduction in time interval between the publication of an advertisement and the declaration of results was achieved in case of major recruitment examinations/selection cases due to adoption of certain innovative measures and speedy implementation of e-governance in the last three years. The aim of the Commission is to develop the existing on-line set up and ultimately to conduct majority of the examinations on-line in order to limit the time gap in respect of publication of results to the bare minimum.

The Public Service Commission, West Bengal, endeavours to instill the highest level of efficiency in the discharge of its duties and responsibilities. The Commission would like to introduce more reforms and adopt new strategies in the coming years in keeping with the demands of the future generation.

Annual Report of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal

PART I

GENERAL

As a body enshrined in the Constitution of India, the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, has sincerely remained active in discharging its constitutional duties and living up to its tradition as inherited from the Bengal Public Service Commission that was formed under the Government of India Act, 1935 and which started functioning with effect from April, 1937. A report on its working during the year 2018-19 is set forth hereunder.

1. The Commission and its composition.

3. Receipt and Expenditure

4. Functions of the Commission :

The Constitution of India has enjoined consultation with the Public Service Commission on matters of appointment and certain other matters as specified in Article 320 in respect of the Civil Services and posts. The Public Service Commission has to perform the duties relating to matters specified in that Article. These include conducting examinations for appointment to Civil Services and posts under the State Government and advising the State Government on all matters relating to methods of recruitment to Civil Services and posts, on the principles to be followed in making appointments to Civil Services and posts and in making promotions and transfers from one service to another, on the suitability of candidates for such appointments, promotions or transfers and on all disciplinary matters affecting a person serving under the State Government in a civil capacity and on certain other matters.

Article 229 and Article 234 also contain provisions in terms of which the Commission is required to be consulted in matters of appointment to certain categories of posts in offices attached to the High Court and to the State Judicial Service respectively. Besides, Acts made for certain statutory bodies contain provisions for consultation with the Commission in matters of appointment to certain categories of posts under such bodies. Article 321 also contains provision in terms of which additional

functions may be entrusted to the Commission by an Act made by the State Legislature as respects the services of the State or any local authority or anybody corporate or any public institution. Such an Act has, however, not been made till now.

The Commission is consulted by the State Govt. in making recruitment to a majority of Civil Services and posts. However, some posts under the State Govt. have been kept outside the purview of the Commission by making regulations in terms of the proviso to Article 320(3) of the Constitution. Such regulations are the West Bengal Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 2008.

5. Workload of the Commission :

A statistical account of the main items of work performed by the Commission during the year 2018-19 is given in the following pages under the caption: **Workload at a Glance.**

During the period under report, the Commission held **955** sittings to interview and select candidates for direct recruitment to various services and posts. Altogether **17,385** candidates were called in for interviews. The Commission continued its practice of inviting experts of different disciplines to assist it in the matter of selection of candidates and thus it maintained liaison with various universities, institutions and organizations.

For direct recruitment by competitive examination with or without interview, the Commission held 11 (Eleven) different kinds of recruitment examinations. There were altogether 13,70,108 candidates applied, 13,95,717 candidates allowed including 25,609 candidates for 4 (Four) Main/Final exams and 9,84,629 candidates appeared for these examinations including 19,204 candidates in the 4 (Four) Main/Final exams. During the year under report, the Commission allotted, 2841 candidates including 621 Scheduled Caste, 176 Scheduled Tribe, 474 (B.C.'A'-266, B.C.'B'-208) Backward Class candidates, 3 Meritorious Sportspersons and 61 candidates from Persons with Disabilities for appointment to different services and posts on the results of different recruitment examinations.

For direct recruitment through selection by interview (with or without preliminary written test) the Commission advertised 1349 posts of different categories and received altogether 4,21,896 applications(including 3,62,564 applications for PST/PWT etc.). Preliminary Written Tests were held for 29 categories of posts for the purpose of short-listing of candidates. After selection, during the period under report, the Commission recommended 1128 candidates including 257 S.C., 55 S.T., 104 B.C.(A), 79 B.C.(B) and 14 P.D. candidates for appointment to different services and posts. The Commission also recommended another 19 candidates including 12 General, 03 S.C. candidate, 03 B.C. - A and 01 B.C. - B candidate for appointment to different services and posts from the reserve lists prepared on earlier selections.

For promotion, the Commission held 100 sittings to discuss the cases with the representatives of the concerned Departments of the State Government. Altogether, 833 vacancies in different services and posts were reported to the Commission for being filled up by promotion. During the period under report, the Commission recommended 807 officers for promotion after considering cases of 2959 officers and could not make any recommendation against 26 vacancies for various reasons.

In disciplinary matters, during the period under report, the Govt. forwarded 99 cases (61 fresh and 38 old) to the Commission for advice. 31 cases had been pending with the Commission till the close of the previous year. The Commission was able to tender its advice only in 22 cases, while the remaining 59 cases were sent back to the Govt. asking for necessary papers/particulars and 49 cases were pending till the closing of the year (i.e. 31/03/2019).

The Commission also tendered advice on framing of recruitment rules for 28 different categories of services and posts and on 06 cases regarding revision of examination rules.

During the year under report, the Commission held Half-Yearly Departmental Examination in May & November, 2018 each time for 6 different categories of officers serving under the Govt. of West Bengal. The total number of registered candidates for the Departmental Examinations was 5,650.

Despite the fact that Commission performs its function according to the rules and regulations, the Commission was impleaded as a Respondent in a number of Court cases during the period under report. The cases were defended as per the rules and regulations as well as on the strength of records relating to the case. 100 fresh litigations, 32 in the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, 67 in the Hon'ble West Bengal Administrative Tribunal and 01 in other Court were filed involving the Commission during the period under report. Out of which 100 cases, 81 cases (30 in the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, 50 in the Hon'ble West Bengal Administrative Tribunal and 01 in other Court) were contested by the Commission. Out of 100 cases, the no. of non contested was 19. Besides, 142 cases (including old pending cases), 04 in the Hon'ble Supreme Court, 66 in the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and 72 in the Hon'ble West Bengal Administrative Tribunal against the Commission are

pending. During the period under report, 55 cases were disposed of, out of which 16 cases were in the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and in 39 cases were in the Hon'ble West Bengal Administrative Tribunal.

Table I intra gives previous and current year's figures on certain items of work.

OBSERVATIONS

A. Requirement of consultation with the Commission regarding promotion:

The Commission has noticed that the proviso to article 320(3)(b) is being interpreted by many Departments of the Government that consultation with the Commission is not necessary for making promotion from one post to another where the posts are (i) within the same service and (ii) not belonging to any service (i.e. the posts of West Bengal General Service). The Commission is of the view that such interpretation would not be in consonance with the spirit of the Constitution. The Patna High Court in the case of Hariprasad Vs. State(AIR 1972, Patna-4) and the Supreme Court in the case of Jammu and Kashmir Vs. Rajadulari Rajdan and others(AIR-1979-SC-586 and 587) gave the judgement in favour of consultation with the Commission in all cases of promotions. It is mentioned in this connection that the Union Public Service Commission after discussion on the point at the National Conference of the Chairmen of the State Public Service Commissions, has sought an amendment to Article 320(3)(b) in its memorandum to the National Commission set up to review the working of the constitution so that the scope of interpreting the existing expression in the Article is obviated and the Commission is consulted in making promotions from one post to another.

The Commission expects that the State Government would consider the matter and take steps so that the Commission is consulted in making promotions from one post to another in all cases.

B. Reporting of vacancies to the Commission for various recruitment examinations:

The Commission has been experiencing difficulties in obtaining estimates of vacancies from the Departments of Government in time. In some cases much delay occurs in reporting vacancies to the Commission despite urgent requests and repeated reminders. Consequently, holding of personality tests after the written examinations in the concerned cases gets deferred and finalization of results of the examination is delayed. Often vacancies are reported long after the completion of personality tests. Such vacancies cannot be accepted for that particular examination and remain to be filled up on the results of the next examination. Needless to mention that an estimate of vacancies is necessary for the Commission to fix up the number of candidates for the personality tests and once the personality test is completed on the basis of the estimated record, further vacancies for the particular examination cannot be accepted.

The Commission feels that it may be possible for the departments of the Government to make a forecast of vacancies to occur in a year due to retirement. Additional vacancies due to resignations and/ or creation of posts can also be accommodated mostly by the time the estimate of vacancies is required for the personality test. Such procedure should be followed in the cases of annual recruitment examinations in view of the difficulties mentioned above.

An annual calendar of vacancies in the posts within the purview of the annual recruitment examinations may be prepared and maintained by the appointing authority so that an estimate of vacancies in the posts for the annual recruitment examinations could be furnished positively by the 31st March of the year of the examinations taking into account the vacancies to be available by the 31st of December of that year.

C. Disciplinary cases- Incomplete reference from Government Departments:

The Commission reiterates its earlier observation that the disciplinary cases are mostly referred to it for advice without furnishing necessary documents and particulars. Such cases are therefore required to be sent back to the departments concerned and thus it is unnecessarily delayed.

D. Extension of Pre-examination training facilities:

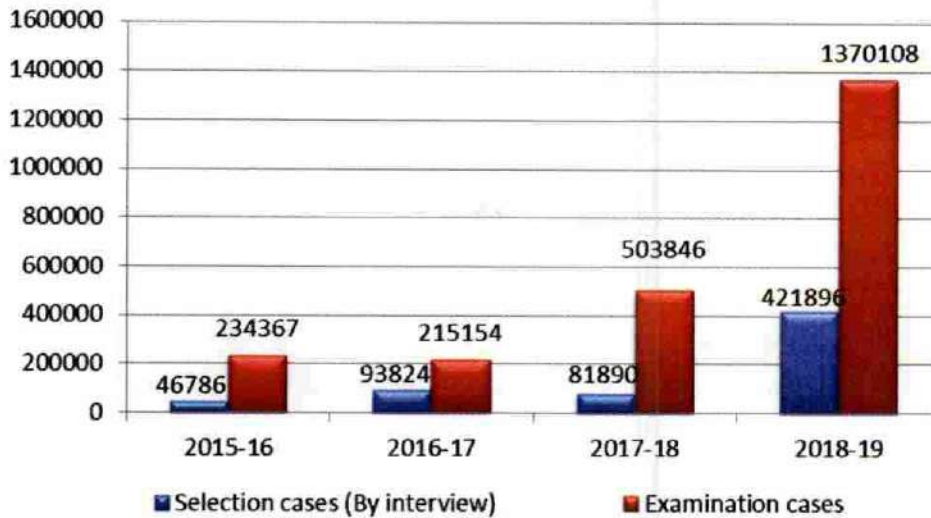
The Commission in its earlier annual reports tendered advice in favour of the extension of the existing facilities of pre-examination training of SC/ST candidates for various recruitment examinations. It is noticed that a good number of vacancies reported for these categories of candidates remained unfilled for want of suitable candidates, even after sufficiently lowering the general standard, during the period under report. The Commission suggests that the Government may consider opening training centres in various places in the state, especially in the tribal concentrated districts.

E. Departmental examinations-Ensuring appearance of the officers at the examinations:

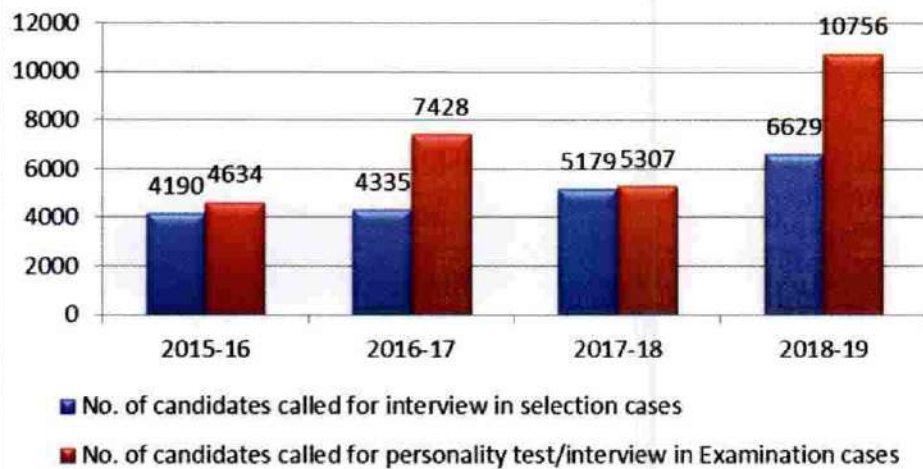
It has come to the notice of the Commission that quite a large number of officers whose cases are forwarded to it and who are admitted to these examinations do not appear at the examinations, causing much inconvenience to the Commission as also wastage of time and drainage of money. So, the Commission suggests that the officers applying for the departmental examinations should be instructed by the departments/officers concerned to appear at the examinations without fail.

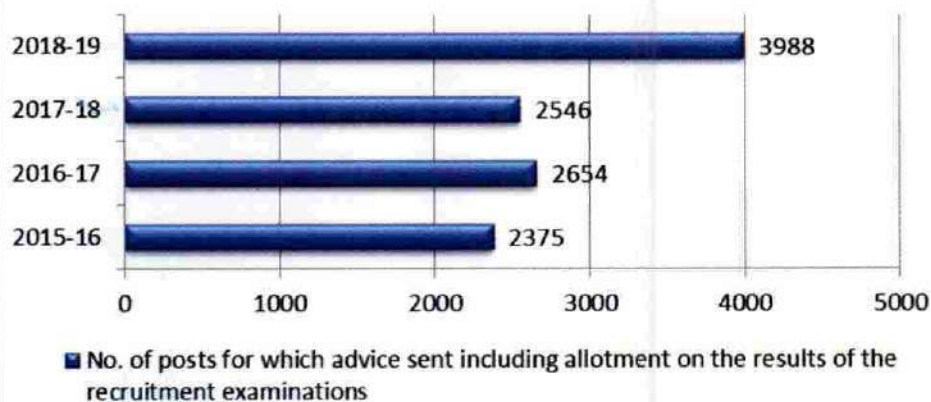
No. of application received for recruitment



No. of candidates called for interview



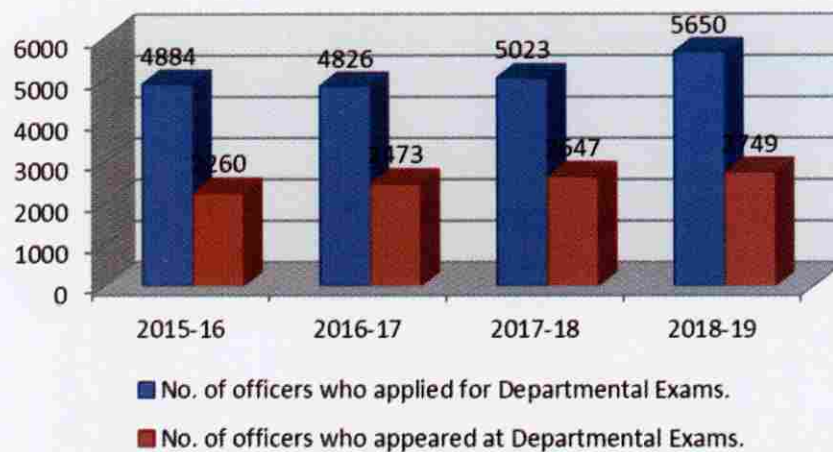
Allotment of candidates on the results of recruitment exams and selection cases



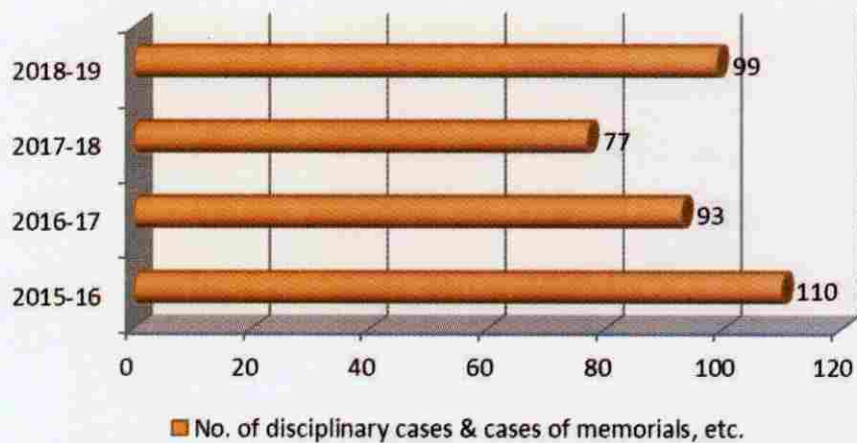
No. of officers considered for promotion



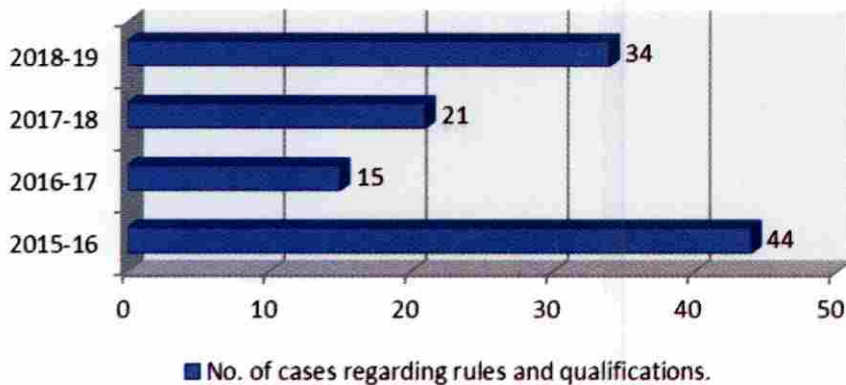
Departmental Exams.

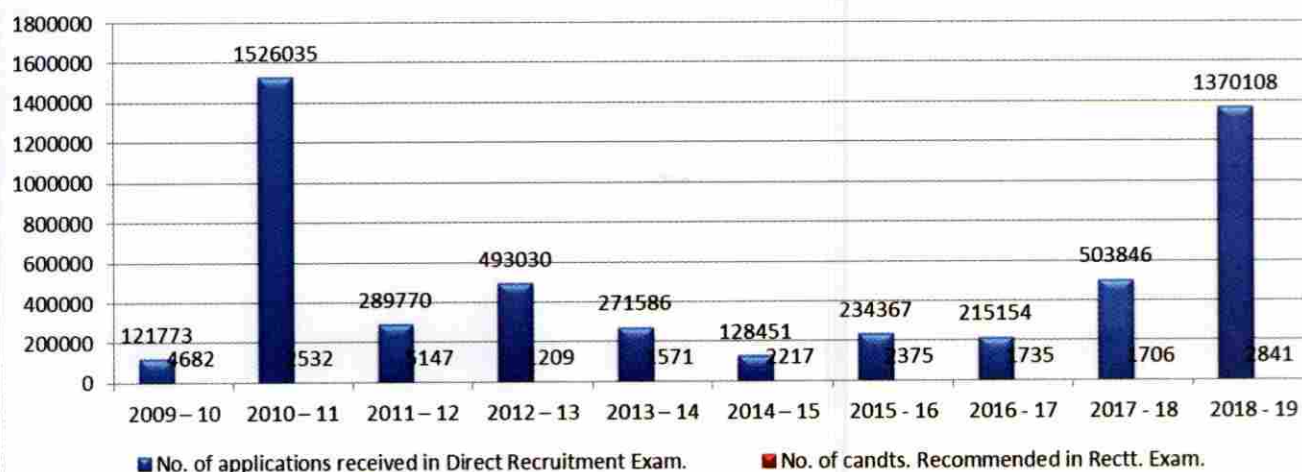

No. of applications received vs. No. of candidates recommended in direct rectt. through selection process

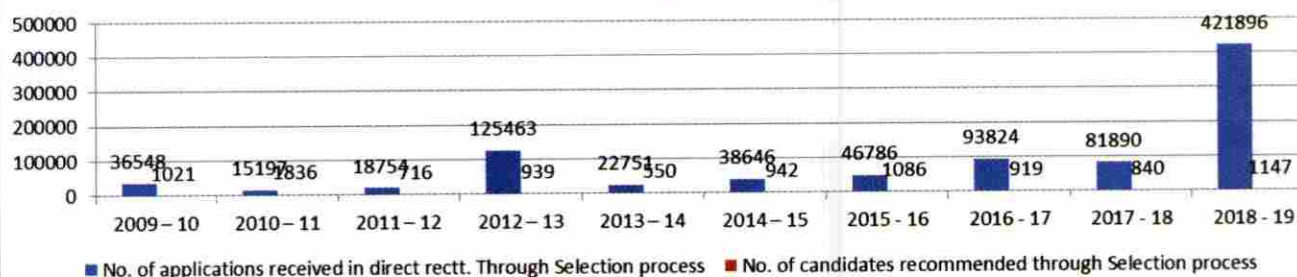

Disciplinary Cases handled by the Commission

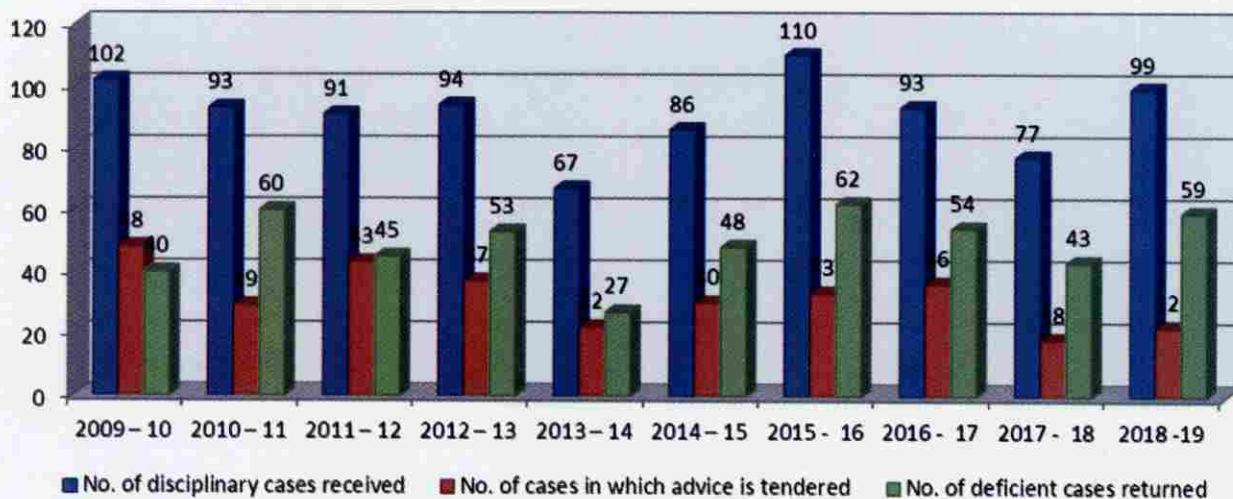

No. of cases of Rectt. Rules advised upon

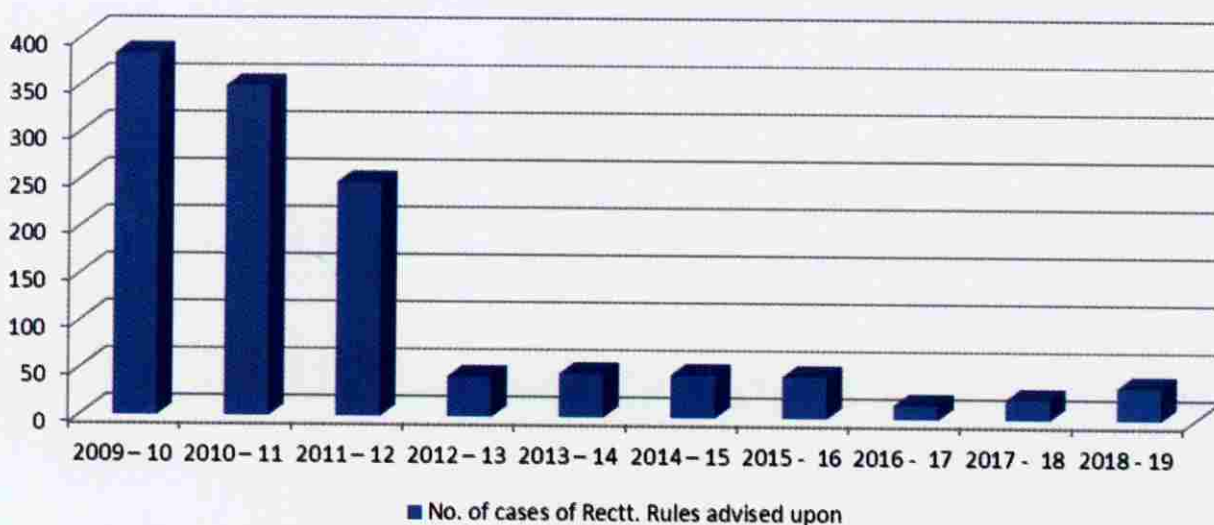

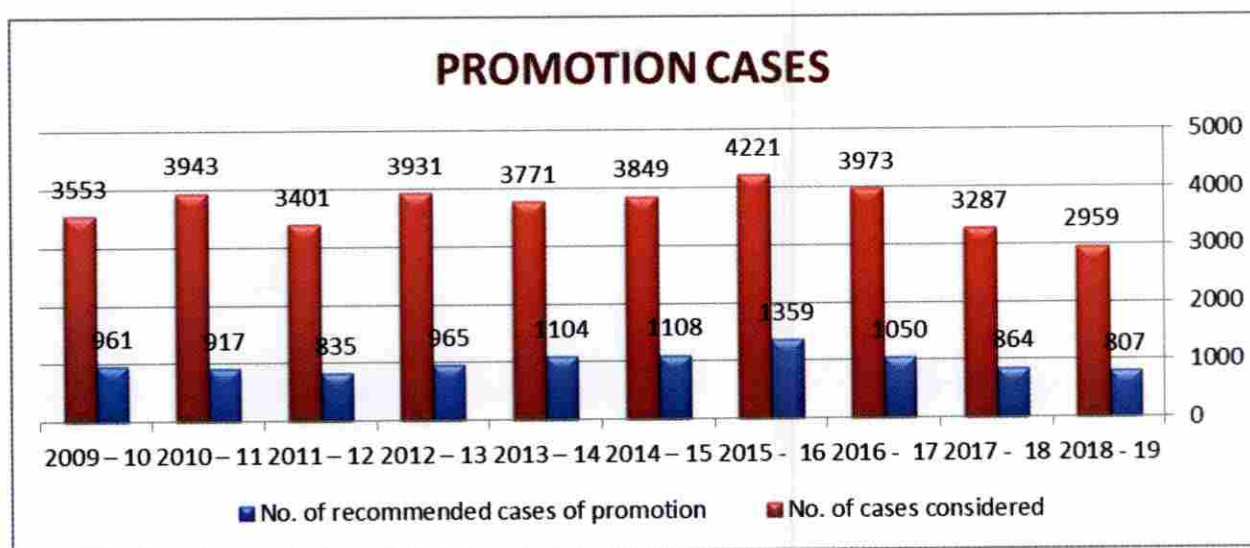
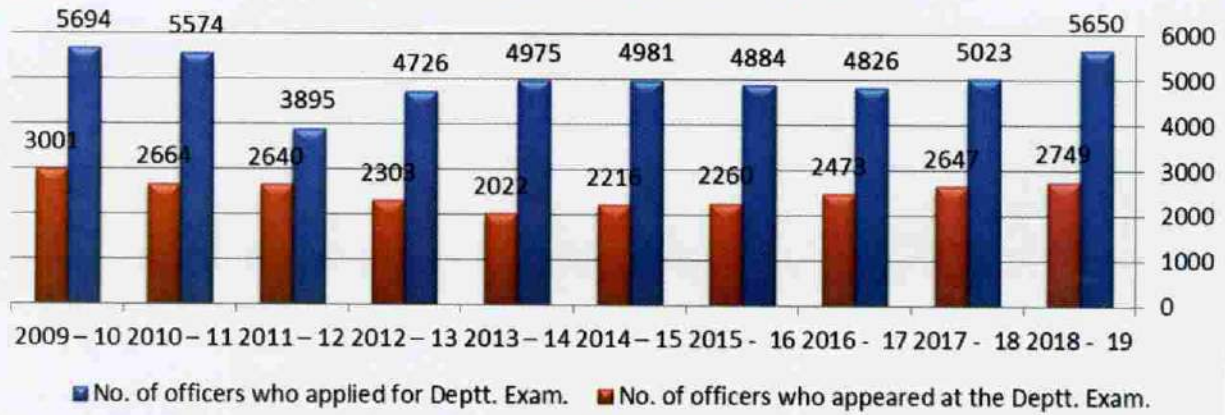

[Details of all examinations are given in **Appendix I (A)**. Darjeeling was included as an Examination Centre for 4(four) Preliminary Recruitment Examinations. 2,534 Candidates applied for the Darjeeling centre of whom 1,815 took their examinations. Darjeeling was included as an Examination Centre for 2(Two) One Stage Recruitment Examinations. . 9,829 Candidates applied for the Darjeeling centre of whom 5,603 took their examinations.]

Important particulars of the recruitment examinations held during the year 2018-2019 are as follows:-

(i) **West Bengal Judicial Service (Preliminary) Examination, 2018 :**

Date of Examination- 10.06.2018

The examination was held at Kolkata and Darjeeling. In all 1,276 candidates applied for the examination of whom 709 candidates took their examination.

(ii) **West Bengal Judicial Service (Final) Examination, 2018 :**

Dates of Examination – 16.07.2018 to 19.07.2018 & 23.07.2018 to 26.07.2018

The examination was held at Kolkata. 239 candidates were allowed for the examination of which 221 candidates took their examination.

(iii) **West Bengal Forest Service & Sub ordinate Forest Service (Preli) Examination, 2018:**

Date of Examination – 05.08.2018 :

The examination was held at 5 centres (Kolkata, Burdwan, Berhampore, Siliguri and Darjeeling). The number of venues in those centres are as follows: Kolkata- 42, Burdwan-08, Berhampore- 05, Siliguri- 07 and Darjeeling-01. In all 23,578 candidates applied for the examination of whom 16,217 appeared at the examination

(iv) **West Bengal Civil Service (Executive) Etc. (Main) Examination, 2018:**

Dates of Examination – 17.08.2018 to 20.08.2018 :

On the basis of the results of preliminary examination, 11,036 candidates were allowed to take the main examination. Finally 9,123 candidates appeared at the examination.

(v) **West Bengal Audit & Accounts Service (Preli) Examination, 2018**

Date of Examination – 08.09.2018

The examination was held at Kolkata and Darjeeling centres. 7,362 candidates applied for the examination of which 4,239 candidates took their examination

(vi) **West Bengal Works Accountant Recruitment Examination, 2018:**

Dates of Examination – 25.11.2018 :

The examination was held in 6 centres throughout West Bengal. The centres were as follows Kolkata -53, Burdwan -09, Medinipur- 06, Berhampore- 05, Siliguri- 07, and Darjeeling- 01 32,904 candidates applied for the examination. Finally, 18,110 candidates appeared at the examination.

(vii) **West Bengal Forest Service & Sub ordinate Forest Service (Final) Examination, 2018:**

Dates of Examination – 11.12.2018 to 22.12.2018

The examination was held at Kolkata only. In all 1854 candidates were allowed to take the examination of whom 1047 candidates appeared at the examination.

(viii) **Miscellaneous Service (Final) Examination, 2018:**

Date of Examination – 13.01.2019

The examination was held at Kolkata only.

In all 12,480 candidates applied for the examination.. Finally, 8,813 candidates appeared at the examination.

(ix) **Competitive Examination for Recruitment to the post of Sub Inspector in the Subordinate Food & Supplies Service, Grade III, under Food & Supplies Deptt, Govt. of West Bengal, 2018:**

Date of Examination : 27.01.2019:

The examination was held in 27 centres throughout West Bengal including Darjeeling. The centres with number of venues were :

Kolkata (North) -125, Kolkata (South)- 88, Baruipur -64 Diamond Harbour -31, Barrackpore -131, Barasat- 144, Krishnagar -206, Howrah-64, Chinsurah -125 Burdwan- 138, Asansol -79, Purulia-109, Medinipur -117, Tamluk-82, Jhargram -35, Bankura -119, Suri 112, Berhampore – 151, Malda – 196, Balurghat-71, Raiganj-84, Jalpaiguri – 85, Alipurduar – 64, Cooch Behar – 113, Siliguri – 84, Kalimpong – 15, Darjeeling – 32. In all 11,06,359 candidates applied and 7,80,849 (apprx.) appeared at the exam.

(x) **West Bengal Civil Service (Executive) Etc. (Preliminary) Examination, 2018 :**

Date of Examination – 09.02.2019

The examination was held in 20 centres throughout West Bengal including Darjeeling. Number of venues at different centres were as follows :-

Kolkata (North) – 66, Kolkata (South) – 38, Baruipur – 20, Diamond Harbour – 06, Barrackpore – 60, Barasat – 37, Howrah – 15, Burdwan – 33, Asansol – 17, Medinipur – 22, Tamluk – 12, Bankura – 16, Berhampore – 34, Malda – 30, Jalpaiguri – 11, Alipurduar – 09, Cooch Behar – 15, Siliguri – 18, Kalimpong – 3, Darjeeling – 5.

In all 1,96,606 candidates applied for the examination all of whom were allowed to appear at the examination. Finally, 1,44,850 candidates appeared at the examination.

(xii) **West Bengal Legal Service Examination, 2018**

Date of Examination – 25.03.2019 to 29.03.2019,

The examination was held at 4 venues including Commission's Examination Halls in Kolkata. Out of 2036 candidates applied for the examination, 451 candidates were present.

LIMITED DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATION

1. Limited Departmental Examination of eligible employees of the Govt. of West Bengal for promotion to the posts in West Bengal Audit and Accounts Service, 2018 : Dates of Examination – 25.09.2018 to 27.09.2018

The examination was held at the Commission's Examination Hall at Kolkata. 828 candidates applied for the examination.. 285 candidates appeared at the examination .

9. DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATIONS:

During the year under report, Half-yearly Departmental/Professional Examination was held in May and November of officers of 6 (six) different categories serving under the Government of West Bengal. In May, 2018, number of officers registered for the examination was 2,891 of whom 1,551 officers appeared. In November, 2018, the number of registered candidates and appeared candidates were 2,759 and 1,198 respectively.

The particulars are given in detail in Appendix – I (E).

10. ADOPTION OF UNFAIRMEANS BY CANDIDATES IN THE EXAMINATIONS CONDUCTED BY THE COMMISSION :

During the year under report, 24 (twenty four) candidates were reported against by the Supervisors of different examination centres for adoption of unfair means in various examinations conducted by the Commission. The particulars of the cases showing the nature of offences and the penal measures taken against them are given in **Appendix – VIII.**

DIRECT RECRUITMENT

11. Recruitment after advertisement and interviews:

During the year under report the Commission considered the proposals from Government reporting altogether 1368 posts of various categories for appointment, after advertisement and interviews or for recommendation from the reserve lists. Details are given in Appendix-II (A) & Appendix-II (B) (synopsis) - 294 of the above posts were reserved for S.C., 110 for S.T., 146 for B.C.(A), 95 for B.C.(B) and 67 for Persons with Disabilities candidates.

Regarding the 1368 posts, as above, the Commission took action as follows –

- (a) Recommended from its previous reserve lists 19 candidates including 03 S.C. , 03 B.C.(A) and 01 B.C.(B) candidates.
- (b) Advertised the remaining 1349 posts including 291 posts reserved for S.C., 110 for S.T., 143 for B.C. (A) , 94 for B.C. (B) and 67 for Persons with Disabilities candidates.

In response to the advertisements mentioned at (b) above 4,21,896 applications(including 3,62,564 applications for PST/PWT etc.) were received.

The number of candidates called for interview during the year under report was 6,629 including 1,633 S.C., 369 S.T., 741 B.C. (A), 838 B.C. (B) and 77 Persons with Disabilities candidates. Out of whom 4,583 candidates including 1,067 S.C., 250 S.T., 554 B.C.(A), 614 B.C.(B). and 59 for Persons with Disabilities candidates appeared at the interviews. The Commission held 535 sittings during the year under report for interviewing the candidates.

Out of 1349 vacancies advertised, the Commission recommended candidates for appointment to 1128 vacancies including 619 General candidates [01 S.C., 03 S.T., 02 B.C. (A), 07 B.C.(B) & 03 P.D. candidates ranked amongst the General candidates on merit were recommended against unreserved vacancies], 257 S.C., 55 S.T., 104 B.C.(A), 79 B.C.(B) and 14 Persons with Disabilities candidates. Due to non-availability of candidates, 221 (including 34 S.C., 55 S.T., 39 B.C.(A), 15 B.C.(B) and 53 for Persons with Disabilities) posts could not be recommended. Of these posts, 58 teaching posts under Education Department and the remaining 163 posts were non-teaching posts requiring technical and /or professional qualification.

In all, therefore, the Commission could recommend 1147 candidates for 100 different categories of posts during the year under report including 260 posts reserved for S.C, 55 for S.T., 107 for B.C.(A), 80 for B.C.(B) and 14 for Persons with Disabilities candidates – of which 19 [12 UR, 03 SC , 03 BC (A) & 01 B.C.(B)] from its earlier reserve lists and 1128 on the basis of advertisements issued by the Commission. During the year under report, Government dealt with the recommendations as follows:

W.B.S.S.C Cases (Superior Posts & Services) :

Regarding the **165** posts of Deptt. of Fire & Emergency Services, WBSSC had done complete procedure (i.e. Written test, Driving test & Interview) of **140** candidates & **110** applications were handed over to PSC for post written exm. procedure (Driving test & Interview). In response to the Advt. of erstwhile WBSSC **6124** application were received (category wise break up was not available). For the said vacancies, Commission took action as follows:-

69 (out of **110**) including **16** for SC, **5** for ST, **9** for OBC category 'A', **9** for OBC category 'B' candidates were called to interview.

Out of **69** candidates **65** candidates including **16** for SC, **5** for ST, **9** for OBC category 'A', **8** for OBC category 'B', appeared at the interviews. The Commission held **4** sitting for interviewing this **65** candidates.

For **165** vacancies, the Commission recommended candidates for appointment to **157** vacancies including **77** for General candidates, **40** for SC, **10** for ST, **19** for OBC category 'A' and **11** for OBC category 'B'. Due to non-availability of suitable candidates **8** (including **7** ST and **1** O.B.C. category 'A') posts could not be recommended.

In last year's Annual Report 7(seven) cases were pending with the Govt. for decision to be taken on the advice of the Commission. Subsequently, the Govt. intimated acceptance of the recommendation of the Commission in 3(three) cases but the decision of the Govt. on remaining 4(four) cases has not been intimated till the close of the year under report.

During the year under report total 1451 (one thousand four hundred fifty one) number of letters were sent to various RTI applicants by the S.P.I.O, P.S.C.W.B under R.T.I Act, 2005 furnishing various information. Amongst all the R.T.I aspirants, 54 (fifty four) made First Appeals to the Appellate Authority, P.S.C.W.B. The S.P.I.O and the Appellate Authority, P.S.C.W.B responsibly accomplished the task of dispatching replies to all the information seekers within the time limit as specified under R.T.I Act, 2005. It is worthwhile to mention that only 13 (thirteen) R.T.I cases were eventually referred to the West Bengal Information Commission.
